#### **Company Overview**





Terminales Graneleras Uruguayas SA (TGU) is an Uruguayan company currently controlled by Ultramar. It is the exclusive operator of the specialized gran terminal of Nueva Palmira's port.

The infrastructure was mostly built by the company, starting from a concession of the Silo Plan established by the government of Uruguay. TGU's concession started in 1999.

Our main services are truck unloading, barges/vessels transferring, storage with different levels of segregation, thermometry and charge to barges/vessels.


- Services provided by TGU are oriented to grain exports from Uruguay, as well as grain exported from the Parana-Paraguay waterway, which covers territories from Paraguay, Argentina, Bolivia and Brazil, to overseas.
- Terminal is strategically located in Nueva Palmira (Km 0 of the Parana-Paraguay waterway) in the western riverbank of Uruguay River.
- Current storage capacity: 85,000 metric tons.
- Output rate: From Terminal to vessels: Up to 1,000 metric tons per hour.
- Input rate: From barges to Terminal: Up to 450 metric tons per hour.









# Throughput








#### Throughput
